100th Year Celebration

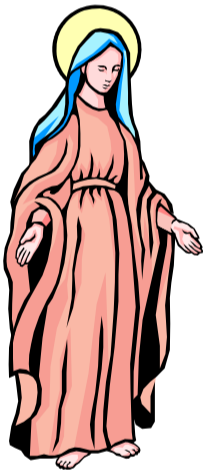
