Golf Tournament

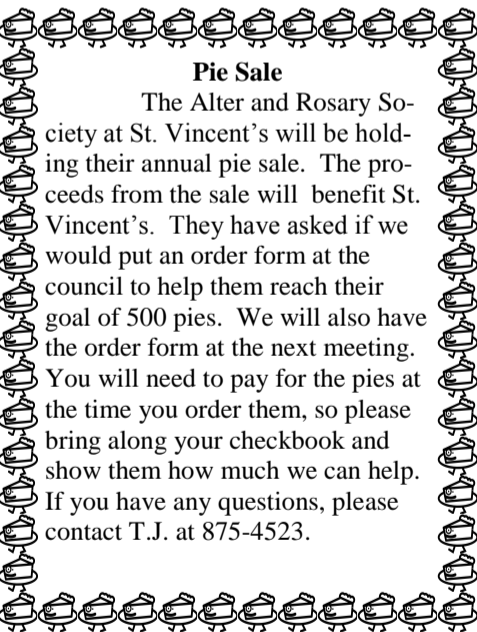
The results of the 2006 Knights of Columbus 1043 Golf Tournament were as follows:
