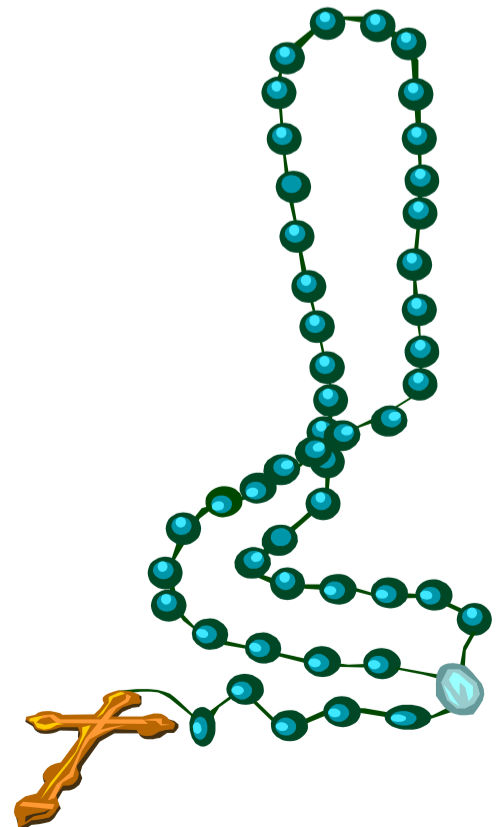
Rosary
